



## Declaration Imports of Steel and Iron Products from Russia

Dear Sir or Madam,

the European Union's (EU) eleventh package of sanctions against Russia tightens the restrictions on imports of steel and iron products by requiring importers of sanctioned steel and iron goods processed in a third country to prove that the inputs used do not come from Russia.

The European Commission adopted Regulation (EU) 2023/1214 amending Regulation (EU) 833/2014 "concerning restrictive measures in view of Russia's actions destabilising the situation in Ukraine." Article 3g establishes that the importation of steel and iron products listed in Annex XVII are prohibited when processed in a third country incorporating steel or iron originating in Russia.

Allied Vision Finning GmbH does not source any of the above materials directly from Russia. Allied Vision Finning GmbH is in close contact with the subcontractors on the above-mentioned topic. We have our suppliers confirm this in writing that none of the above-mentioned materials are used in the products.
